Esser III Plan

- **Distribution of how funds will be used to implement prevention and mitigation strategies that are consistent with the most recent CDC guidance on reopening schools, in order to continuously and safely open and operate schools for in-person learning:** We will have an initial deep clean cleaning service, A1 Cleaning sanitize each classroom and buildings of operation including cafeteria and library. This will include all air filters to ensure better quality air. Precision Carpet Cleaning will also be cleaning all carpets throughout the campus. These two services will be complete before our staff and students begin the school year. These two services will be vital in staying safe when dealing with Covid 19.
- **Implementation of interventions that we will respond to emotional, and academic needs of students who have been impacted by COVID-19, including students from low-income families, students of color, English learners, children with disabilities, students experiencing homelessness, children in foster care and migratory students:** CLA will hire an additional paraprofessional to respond to the academic, social and emotional need of students who have been impacted by COVID 19, including students from low-income families, students of color, English language learners, children with disabilities, students experiencing homelessness, children in foster care and migratory students. Also, Counseling will be provided to address the social-emotional-behavioral and mental health needs of low-income students, children with disabilities, English Learners, racial and ethnic minorities, homelessness, and foster care youth. These services will be provided throughout the day when needed. The counselor will meet with these groups of students, not individually weekly with each grade level to discuss how students are doing in the classroom, handling homework, relationships with teachers and

other students, and home environment to determine if individual counseling is needed. There are no funds in 795 for this.

- **The LEA will use Funds to address the academic impact of lost instructional time:** Wave 11, (an IT Service), will contract with CLA to provide IT services to ensure staff and students can successfully engage in online programs that will help with learning loss during COVID 19. Wave 11 will also be instrumental for staff when communicating with virtual students using Google Classroom and Google Meets.
- **How the LEA will spend its remaining ARP ESSER funds:** The use of funds will be used for additional IT services and paraprofessionals to continue combating emotional needs and academic loss our students have experienced with COVID 19.
